On this day in history.....

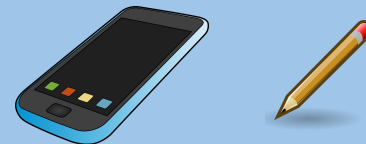
1519 - Cortez landed in Mexico.
