


# BYOD (Bring Your Own Device\*)

\*Note device includes but is not limited to the following items: phone, iPad, iPod, tablet, laptop, ear buds, headphones , air pods...



# Why BYOD at AFMS

- To help teach students how to better use and understand the devices they already have
  - To increase the digital citizenship of our students
  - To provide more engaging opportunities for students to be actively participating in the **Four C's** (communication, collaboration, creativity and critical thinking)

- **Parents:** Do not feel pressured to BUY a device. Each classroom has 10 laptops for student use.

# The Device stop light...

## RED

No device will be used. Leave the device turned off and in your backpack or locker. The device should not be visible.

## YELLOW

Device should be in the parking lot position. This means the device is face down on top of the table. Headphones and earbuds should not be used.

## GREEN

Device can be out and used appropriately for instruction. Headphones and earbuds are OK to use when teacher permits.

# To participate in BYOD you must...



Have a signed  
**BYOD Form** on file.

Be responsible for  
your own device  
(take care of it and  
do not leave it  
behind).

Remember that just  
because you have  
permission to use  
your device in one  
room does not  
mean you can do so  
in other classes.

# “No Touch” policy

1.

Students and teachers will not be able to touch devices that are not their own.

4.

Teachers can still confiscate your device in the classroom. They will use a basket to do so. Please follow instructions if they ask for your device.

2.

This means a teacher or student will not touch your device if help is needed; instead, the teacher will walk you through the troubleshooting process.

5.

If a teacher confiscates your device then it will be locked away and returned at the end of the class period.

3.

The exception to this rule is in the “Red Zones” where teachers can touch devices if the rule is violated.

6.

Get in the habit of not allowing peers to touch your device as each student needs to be responsible for their belongings.

# Consequences for failure to comply

<b>1</b>	Device will be confiscated for the remainder of the period	
<b>2</b>	Device will be confiscated for the remainder of the period	
<b>3</b>	Device will not be used in specific class for five days	Will be turned in daily before class begins
<b>4</b>	Referral to Administration	1st Referral= 1 Full Day 2nd Referral= 1 Night 3rd Referral= 3 Nights 4th Referral= 5 Nights & Pick Up by Parent

Failure to comply with your teacher results in an automatic referral

No devices should ever be used in the Red Zones.

-Cafeteria

-Bathrooms

-Locker Rooms

-Hallways

# ***CONSEQUENCES IN RED ZONES***

Cafeteria\*Hallways\*Locker Rooms\*Bathrooms

**1** Student loses device until the end of the day

**2** Student will lose for one night (pick up at the end of second day)

**3** Student loses phone for three nights

**4** Student loses phone for five nights and must be picked up by a parent/guardian

# Schedule cont..
